At the conclusion of the product-roadmap discussion, the team demonstrated updates to the emsCharts Analytics and Reporting modules, as well as the recently enhanced HL7 product which is currently in production at several hospital systems across the country. The goal of all of these products is to continue to reduce time spent during patient transfer and simplify continuity of care, which will ultimately improve patient outcomes.
